

**CLINIC PROTOCOL  
FOR ALL INCOMING CATS  
FOR CAT ACTION TEAM  
SPAY/NEUTER PROGRAM**

- All cats must be vaccinated for FVRCP
- All cats must be vaccinated against Rabies
- All cats to receive parasite treatment (currently using Ivomectin at private clinics and Revolution at AVC)
- All cats to receive pain medication/anti-inflammatory (currently using Rimadyl because it is also an anti-inflammatory and is effective for 3 days)
- All cats to receive injectable antibiotic (currently using Polyflex)
- In addition to the Polyflex, all cats to receive long-lasting antibiotic if deemed necessary for any URI, wounds, infections or other symptoms as recommended by attending vet (currently using Convenia)
- In addition to the Ivomectin, all cats should receive parasite treatment for tapeworm if there is evidence of tapeworm present (currently using Droncit)
- Continue with FeLV/FIV testing only when deemed necessary by attending vet (this policy was changed in March, 2012).
- All cats must be tattooed in left ear with colony code
